

## **Recognizing and Receiving God's Gifts**

October 20, 2019 Twenty-ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time Ex 17:8-13, 2 Tim 3:14-4:2, Lk 18:1-8

Today's readings address the need for persistence in our faith and stewardship. In the first reading, Moses grows tired and requires the support of Aaron and Hur as he participates in God's work. Similarly, our own stewardship can often be difficult, causing us to request the help of others. In the gospel, we hear the parable of the corrupt judge and the *very* persistent widow. The judge finally rules in her favor, not because he cares about her or her cause, but because he fears repercussions if he does not grant her request. Jesus teaches that we should be this persistent in our prayer to God, who does care about us and our needs. When we begin to grow weary in our prayer, we should turn to our friends and neighbors who can pray with us. This week, pray that the Holy Spirit empowers you with persistence in faith and prayer!
